While the greater community is opening at a quicker pace and dropping the mask mandates, we are required to follow the regulations from the State Department of Health, CMS, and the CDC. As the vaccination rates increase, it does allow more flexibility for visitation. The risk of variant strains of COVID-19 and the spread of COVID-19 to unvaccinated Residents and Staff still exists.

Volunteers and staff will monitor for compliance with the Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention during visitation hours.

Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Prevention:

- 1. Screening, of all who enter the facility, for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, and denial of entry of those with signs or symptoms or those who have had contact with someone with COVID-19 infection in the prior 14 days. (regardless of the visitor(s) vaccination status)
- 2. Hand Hygiene
- 3. Face covering or mask (covering mouth <u>and</u> nose) and social distancing at least six feet between persons *unless* both the Resident and visitor(s) are fully vaccinated, physical touch can then be allowed.
- 4. Cleaning and disinfecting high frequency touched surfaces in the facility often, and designated visitation areas after each visit.

Definitions:

<u>Private Setting:</u> A private setting is either a designated visitation area on the South Unit or a Private Resident room.

<u>Fully vaccinated</u>: A person is considered fully vaccinated greater than or equal to 2 weeks following the receipt of the second dose of either

the Moderna or the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine, or greater than or equal to 2 weeks following the receipt of the Johnson and

Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.
