### Contest & Exhibit Guidelines:

The contest is open to *amateur* artists from Holmes County and the greater Holmes County area (within approximately two (2) miles of the Holmes County line), and there is no entry fee. The artist must have completed the work when he/she was at least 55 years old. Up to three entries may be submitted per artist, and one entry form should be completed for each entry. The final determination of the category for each piece will be at the discretion of the Art Show Committee. Each entry is eligible to win in one category only. Artwork that was entered in a previous year’s contest may be re-entered if the piece has not won a First or Second Place award. Visitors to the Exhibit will vote for the People’s Choice. Except for the People’s Choice Award, winners will be announced at the Meet the Artist Reception on Friday, August 19 from 6 to 8 p.m. The Exhibit will be open to the public on Saturday, August 20, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**All entry forms must be submitted by August 5, 2022.** Information on artwork drop off will be communicated to all artists after the entry deadline.
